

# Pay by card online

## Open round the clock and handles all the cards in the world

A common way of paying on the Internet is by card: Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Maestro, Diners or certain other payment cards and e-gift cards.

When a customer pays by card on the Internet this is done on the order/payment page. He or she then chooses the payment method, e.g. card details. The details are sent via our payment service provider to the card issuer for verification and reservation of money. The amount is drawn from the card account/authorised overdraft facility in the same way as when the customer uses the card to pay for a purchase in a physical store.

To ensure that it works with our e-commerce solution internationally, you need to have a Nordic bank that acquires your card transactions. Your website should also have options for selecting language and delivery country for the purchased product or service. We also recommend verification of the address and the person that is registered at the address. This is to verify the buyer together with the banks' verification via our services.

Together with Posten's distribution and our payment services, a delivery of a product will therefore be very secure, provided that our recommendations are followed.
